Deep Dish Waves of Change is offering a professional opportunity for 5 female New York City high school students. This paid Summer Internship Program is open to all high schoolers living in Community Board 9 who are interested in learning more about web design/development and journalism. The internship runs July - August 2013. Interns selected must commit to the full program and are required to attend weekly sessions. Interns will receive a \$750 stipend plus transportation.

Accepted students will receive a \$750 stipend and will have an option to continue to work with the project during the academic year at a regular salary.

Students must be able to commit to all of the following dates:

- **Summer Internship:** July - August 2013 . 1 -2 days per week and outside class time work.
- **Location:** Primary: Local Library in West/Central Harlem; Secondary: Community field work
